What's at stake if Prop One passes?

- ▶ The New York State government could have more authority than parents in making medical and other important decisions for children.
- ▶ Children under the age of 18 could have the right to medical procedures, including irreversible "gender affirming" procedures without parental notice or approval.
- ▶ Biological males could be allowed to compete against biological females in school sports without restrictions.
- ▶ Schools could be banned from disclosing to parents that their children are choosing to conduct themselves as transgender.
- ▶ Protections for religious institutions regarding outreach and services could be eroded.

Text of the proposed amendment:
Proposed changes to Article 1, Section 11 of the New York State Constitution...
§ 11. A. No person shall be denied the equal protection of the laws of this state or any subdivision thereof. No person shall, because of race, color, ETHNICITY, NATIONAL ORIGIN, AGE, DISABILITY, creed [or] religion, OR SEX INCLUDING SEXUAL ORIENTATION, GENDER IDENTITY, GENDER EXPRESSION, PREGNANCY, PREGNANCY OUTCOMES, AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTHCARE AND AUTONOMY, be subjected to any discrimination in [his or her] THEIR civil rights by any other person or by any firm, corporation, or institution, or by the state or any agency or subdivision of the state, PURSUANT TO LAW.
B. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL INVALIDATE OR PREVENT THE ADOPTION OF ANY LAW, REGULATION, PROGRAM, OR PRACTICE THAT IS DESIGNED TO PREVENT OR DISMANTLE DISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF A CHARACTERISTIC LISTED IN THIS SECTION, NOR SHALL ANY CHARACTERISTIC LISTED IN THIS SECTION BE INTERPRETED TO INTERFERE WITH, LIMIT, OR DENY THE CIVIL RIGHTS OF ANY PERSON BASED UPON ANY OTHER CHARACTERISTIC IDENTIFIED IN THIS SECTION.

Deadline to register is Oct. 26
You can register online at www.ny.gov or in person at your local Board of Elections (BOE) or at participating NY State Agencies.

Standard Voting:

In-person on Election Day:
Nov. 5, 2024
6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Early Voting:

Voters are provided with nine days to vote in person prior to Election Day. Early voting dates and hours of operation are provided by local County Board of Elections. You can obtain an absentee ballot by checking box #15 on a standard voting registration application.

Requesting an absentee ballot:

Online: Deadline is Oct. 26, 2024
Mail: Deadline Oct. 26, 2024 (Request-Applications must be received by Oct. 26)
In person: From your local BOE

Further things to consider...

Prop One, Albany's purposed amendment to the New York State Constitution threatens free speech and religious rights. The ERA empowers courts to force religious institutions to dilute their principled teachings or sincerely held beliefs especially where they run contrary to affirming transgender care for minors.

In addition, under paragraph B:

Discrimination becomes a NY State constitutional right provided the discrimination is "designed to prevent or dismantle discrimination."

Discrimination against certain groups in order to protect other groups would be exempt from the sweeping protections currently under the NY State Constitution, and the vague rights outlined in paragraph A of the ERA.

Arguably, that would mean NYS Human Rights Laws could be preempted merely by claiming the motivation was to "dismantle discrimination."



What does this mean for:

Hospitals that don't want to perform abortion or gender reassignment surgery on minors?

The NYS Department of Education 2023 Legal Update and "Best Practices" Document advises schools on how to handle students looking to transition to the opposite gender.

Below are a few shocking excerpts:

"Students are not required to obtain parental/guardian consent or a court-ordered name and/or gender change before being addressed by their affirmed name and pronouns."

"The student is in charge of their gender transition and the school's role is to provide support."

"Some TGE students have not talked to their families about their gender identity because of safety concerns or lack of acceptance and may begin their transition at school without parent/guardian knowledge."

If Prop One passes on Nov. 5th by popular vote the doors open for courts to uphold legislation and the NYS Dept. of Ed. Best practices, that deprive parents of their God given parental authority and responsibility.

Two examples of pending bills that strip parents of their rights:

- A6761 - Would allow minors to make their own medical decisions without parental knowledge or consent. Medical decisions include procedures related to medical, dental, health, and hospital services.
- S762A / A276B - Provides treatment for sexually transmitted diseases to minors without a parental consent.

Prop One or the ERA's passage would constitutionalize not only a right to destroy unborn human beings throughout all nine months of pregnancy– on demand– but **threaten** the few **safeguards** that exist in NY surrounding abortion. **Prop one will also jeopardize** the ability of the NY State Legislature to enact and implement **common-sense standards** or requirements regarding abortion including:

- parental notification when minors seek abortions,
- informed consent, distribution of information to abortion patients containing published peer-reviewed studies on abortion's negative health impacts,
- 24–48 hour wait periods between abortion appointments and the procedure,
- tracking, reporting and publishing abortion complication data,
- annual or random state health department abortion clinic inspections,
- pre-abortion (including chemical abortion) pregnancy ultrasounds,
- distribution of information to abortion patients on adoption services and embryonic and fetal development.

Prop One puts **all unborn children, regardless of age, sex, disability, national origin, ethnicity, or race at risk of lethal violence**. Living preborn children will be in danger of death more than ever before in NY.

Rates of late-term abortions are likely to increase in NY. Approximately 2,000 children are killed by abortion on average annually in NY, at 20+ weeks gestation, according to NY's most recent, published vital statistics spanning a 10 year period.

Rates of abortions experienced by minors are likely to increase in NY. According to NY's most recently published vital statistics on abortion over a five year period, more than 6,000 abortions occur on females 20 years old and younger, on average annually. Thousands of those undergoing these abortions are minors 17 years old and younger.
